

**In Re: Complaint dated 20.11.2025 made by Mr. Suresh Kumar Sharma, in relation to the overage of Mr. Vaibhav Sharma, sent to the Ethics Officer, Board of Control for Cricket in India.**

**ORDER**

1. The complaint pertains to the age of Mr. Vaibhav Sharma, son of the complainant. It is alleged in the complaint that, as per TW3 Medical Examination of Mr. Vaibhav Sharma conducted at Fortis Hospital Mohali for U-16 State Tournament for Vijay Merchant Trophy, the age of Mr. Vaibhav Sharma is 16.5 years and he is not eligible for the said Tournament, but on personal level TW3 Medical Examination done at Fortis Hospital Ludhiana, the age is 14.9 years as per report. Further, the complainant prayed for re-medical examination of TW3 of Mr. Vaibhav Sharma in presence of expert medical examination/panel for exact clarity of the age.
2. The complaint pertains to selection in the team of Mr. Vaibhav Sharma U-16 State Tournament for Vijay Merchant Trophy. The issue raised is not within the jurisdiction of Ombudsman/Ethics Officer, BCCI. Complainant is at liberty to approach appropriate authority/committee constituted under Rule 26 (B) of the Rules and Regulations of the BCCI for redressal of the grievance.
3. Complaint is disposed of accordingly.
