4. Key Accountabilities:

- The successful candidate will be responsible for developing a world class bowling outfit that delivers sustained success in all conditions and formats.
- The Bowling Coach will have overall responsibility for the bowling performance and management of the athletes in all three forms of the game.
- Develop and monitor bowling objectives and Key Performance Indicators (KPI 's) for inclusion in Individual Bowlers Performance Plans.
- Develop positive and strong working relationships, and work closely with other specialist coaches and NCA Coaches
- Work closely with the Head Strength and Conditioning Coach and Head Physiotherapist in applying appropriate strength and conditioning principles relevant to bowling. Use Bio-mechanical principles along with Head Strength and Conditioning Coach to deliver a bowling program which adheres to modern sports science tenets.
- Undertake, develop, and monitor a workload management plan for all bowlers (contracted and identified)
- Use GPS enabled devices or similar performance measurement devices to develop specific algorithms to develop metrics which are relevant to bowling and act as a Key performance Indicators for bowlers.
- Observe bowlers in elite competitions as advised by the National Academy Head Cricket or Selectors.
