ORDER

A complaint has been filed by Ms. Ms. S. N. Vidya Yadav in respect of the Election of Ms. Vanka Roma Singh as Female ICA Representative Nominee to Apex Body of HCA alleging conflict of interest on the part of Ms. Vanka Roma Singh.



However, the said complaint has been filed without an affidavit and thus is not in compliance with the Practice Directions 01/2019.

Even otherwise, the issue raised by the complainant does not form part of the scope and ambit of the Ethics Officer (elaborated in Rule 39 of the BCCI Rules and Regulations). Moreover, the rules cited in the complaint refer to the conflict of interest provisions in the Rules and Regulations of HCA and not BCCI. Even the finding of the Election Officer that has been relied upon to file the said complaint is for the “objectors” to “approach the Ethics Officer, HCA for appropriate relief” and not the Ethics Officer of BCCI.

Thus, in view of the above, the said complaint is not maintainable and is dismissed for want of jurisdiction.
