

**Information regarding meetings of the *Amicus Curiae* with the parties before the Court.**

1<sup>st</sup> April, 2019

1. By order dated 17.01.2019 the Supreme Court of India appointed Sh. P.S. Narasimha as *Amicus Curiae* to assist the Court in the cases concerning BCCI, State Cricket Associations and Others.
2. By order dated 14.03.2019, the Court passed the following order:

“.....

*By consent of all the parties, Mr. P.S. Narasimha, learned Amicus Curiae, is appointed by this Court to act as a Mediator in relation to any dispute that might arise in the instant interlocutory applications pending before us. ... ”*
