DECISION DATED 06.09.2019 OF THE SUPREME COURT APPOINTED COMMITTEE OF ADMINISTRATORS IN RESPECT OF BIHAR CRICKET ASSOCIATION

- 1. The Committee of Administrators at the meeting on 6th September, 2019 deliberated the issues which formed part of the Report submitted by BCCI in relation to the functioning and administration of the Bihar Cricket Association (BCA) to the Committee of Administrators.
- 2. After deliberating the issues at length the Committee of Administrators was satisfied that it was imperative for the proper administration and management of the game of cricket in Bihar and the ongoing election process in conducted in a free, fair and transparent manner that the BCA's management is put under supervision and control of an Independent Supervisory Committee constituted by the Committee of Administrators of the BCCI with full powers to supervise the management and functioning of the BCA including but not limited to:
 - i. supervise, regulate and suspend the powers, duties and functioning of all post holders in the BCA;
 - ii. the power to continue or appoint or replace Electoral Officer, Ombudsman and Ethics Officer;
 - iii. to appoint Selectors, Team Officials and Match Officials;
 - iv. appoint auditors to investigate utilization of funds granted by the BCCI.
- 3. The composition of the said Independent Supervisory Committee shall be as follows:
 - i. Mr. Alok Kumar (BCCI, ACU), who shall act as the Chairman,
 - ii. Mr. Alwin Gaekwad (BCCI Cricket Operations) and
 - iii. Mr. Sandeep Wagle (BCCI Finance).
- 4. The BCA is hereby directed to co-operate with and comply with the directions of the said Independent Supervisory Committee. The Independent Supervisory Committee will report directly to the Committee of Administrators and submit a status report on a weekly basis.
- 5. Further, it is directed that the management of the BCA shall not release any funds without written approval from the aforesaid Independent Supervisory Committee.
- 6. Please note in case the BCA doesn't comply and cooperate with the Independent Supervisory Committee, the Committee of Administrators will not have any other option but to suspend the membership of the Bihar Cricket Association with immediate effect and direct the BCCI to run cricket operations directly in the State of Bihar.
