

# CONSTITUTION OF MADHYA PRADESH CRICKET ASSOCIATION INDORE

(A Society registered under M.P. Societies Registration Act, 1973 Registration No. 4751)

(As amended on 15<sup>th</sup> September 2019)

1	Where it is expedient to regulate, promote, supervise, control and organise cricket played within the jurisdiction of Madhya Pradesh it is hereby laid down as follows :
2	Short Title : This CONSTITUTION shall be called the constitution of Madhya Pradesh Cricket Association.
3	Commencement : It shall come into force immediately (i.e. with effect from 21st August 1960).
4	Jurisdiction : The jurisdiction of the Association shall extend over the State of Madhya Pradesh and over any other territory assigned to it by the Board of Control for Cricket in India.
5	Headquarter : The headquarter of the Association shall be at Indore.
6	In this Constitution unless the context otherwise requires:
6 (a)	'Affiliation' in relation to a Divisional Association and institution means affiliated to the Association on payment of the prescribed fees and admitted as such;
6 (a.a)	'Administrator' shall mean and include present and former Office-bearer of the Association, past and present President and Secretary of the Institutional Member of the Association, a representative of the Institutional Member of the Association, and any person connected with the governance and management of the affairs of the Association or of its committees;
6(b)	'Association' means the Madhya Pradesh Cricket Association;
6(c)	'Board' means the Board of Control for Cricket in India;

6(d)	'Constitution' means the Constitution of the Association;
6 (e)	'Committee' means the Managing Committee of the Association;
6 (e.a)	<b>'Cricket Players' Association' means the Cricket Players' Association as per the BCCI Constitution.</b>
6 (f)	'Divisional Association' means the Association of a Division as formed under clause 24;
6(g)	'General Body' means a body consisting of all the members;
6(h)	'Honorary Life Member' means a person who has been recognised as such under clause 10;
6(i)	'Member' means a person, an institution and a Divisional Association admitted to the membership of the Association under this constitution;
6(i.a)	'Match Official' means Umpires, Match Referees, Scorers, Match Observers, Anti Corruption Officials appointed by the Association or the Board for conduct of any match, or any person appointed for any other such roles as decided by Committee;
6 (j)	'Office-bearer' means the President, Vice President, Hon. Secretary, Hon. Joint Secretary and Hon. Treasurer. The term 'Hon.' is abbreviated form of 'Honorary';
6(k)	'Registrar' : Means Registrar of Firms & Societies of Madhya Pradesh
6(l)	'Representative Match' means a cricket match played by or on behalf of the Association and approved by the Committee;
6(m)	'Rules and Bye - laws' means the rules and bye-laws framed under this Constitution;
6(m.a)	'Sub-committee' means any sub-committee constituted for any specific purpose by the General Body or the Committee. <b>A 'Cricket Committee' means the sub-committee constituted by the General Body for the tasks elaborated at 29 (A) of the Constitution. Cricket Committee shall comprise of three former cricketers who have played atleast 10 First Class matches.</b>
6(m.b)	'Team Official' means Coaches, Managers , Physiotherapist, Nutritionist ,Trainers , Analyst, Counsellors and Medics appointed by the Association for a team, or any person appointed for any other such roles as decided by Committee.
6(n)	Deleted
6(o)	Year means a Financial year commencing from 1 <sup>st</sup> April and ending on 31 <sup>st</sup> March, unless specified otherwise in the Constitution.
7	<p>Membership : The Membership of the Association shall be open to :</p> <p>(a) Institutional Member : Institutional teams playing Cricket, including Divisional Associations within the jurisdiction of the Association.</p> <p>(b) Life Members :</p> <p>i. Individual persons who are interested in the game of Cricket and its promotion and who qualify the provision 11 (A).</p>

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		<p>ii. A player hailing from Madhya Pradesh who has been selected for Indian Team (Senior Men / Women) either for Test or One Day or T-20 matches shall automatically become Life Member of the Association after his / her retirement from all formats of the game, subject to the written intimation of this to the Association and upon fulfilling the eligibility criteria of the Membership of the Association as per clause 11 (A).</p>
8		<p>Fees for Institutional Membership : No cricket playing institution nor Divisional Association shall be admitted to the membership unless it pays such annual subscription as may be decided by the Committee from time to time. Present subscription is Rs. 250/-.</p> <p>Provided further that no such institution shall be admitted to the membership unless it is first affiliated with the Divisional Association and has participated in any tournament recognised by the Association or the Divisional Association.</p> <p>Explanations :-</p> <p>(i) The aforesaid condition shall not apply to any institution affiliated to the Association before 21-06-2008</p> <p>(ii) If any Divisional Association is not conducting any tournament then the cricket club or institution applying for the membership must participate in some tournament suggested by the Committee.</p>
9		<p>Fees for Life Members :</p> <p>(a) Any individual person may become the Life Member of the Association on payment of such fees as may be decided by the Committee from time to time, provided that the fees shall not be less than Rs. 5000/- and statutory taxes if any. (Note : This clause shall not affect persons who were admitted as Life Members before 21.06.2008).</p> <p>(b) A person who applies for Life membership shall have to deposit the fees by a cheque of an amount as stated in (a) above along with the prescribed application form.</p> <p>(c) International players shall not pay any fee for membership under clause 7 (b) (ii).</p>
10		<p>Honorary Life Member : The Association may confer the Honorary Life Membership on any distinguished cricketer or other individual who has served the Association in any honorary capacity.</p>

  
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11	<p>Qualification for Life Membership :</p> <p>(a) A person intending to be a Life Member of the Association must have attained the age of 25 years on the date of application.</p> <p>(b) Subject to clause 11 (a), not more than 6 persons shall be admitted as Members under clause 7 (b) (1) per year between 1<sup>st</sup> September and 31<sup>st</sup> August of subsequent year, out of which two persons shall be a male cricketer or umpire, one person shall be a female cricketer, and three persons shall be from the General category, subject to fulfilment of following conditions :-</p> <p>(i) The Male Cricketer should have played Ranji Trophy matches (i.e. more than one match) for Madhya Pradesh and should have officially retired from First Class Cricket, provided further that such player has applied for the membership one year after his retirement.</p> <p>(ii) The Umpire should have umpired in 50 or more multi-day matches conducted by the Board and should not be less than 35 years of age.</p> <p>(iii) The Female Cricketer should have played matches of National Championship for Madhya Pradesh and should have officially retired from National / First Class Cricket, provided further that such player has applied for the membership one year after her retirement.</p> <p>(iv) The other three Members will be from General Category out of persons who are actually involved in organising and promoting the game of cricket for at least three years.</p> <p>(v) If, for whatever reason, applicants from Male Cricketer/Umpire category are not admitted then all five persons shall be admitted from the General Category and vice-versa at the discretion of the Committee.</p> <p>(vi) If, for whatever reason, applicant under the Female Cricketer category is not admitted then this category shall remain vacant.</p> <p>(vii) The Committee will have the power to fill up the allotted quota of six Members or part thereof in subsequent one year if the same has/have not been filled in the corresponding year, subject to the provisions mentioned in rule 11 (a) &amp; (b).</p> <p>The membership shall be confirmed subject to credit of the required admission fee within 30 days from the admission of the applicant to the membership by the Committee.</p>
11	(c) Deleted
11	<p>(d) In addition to the above, one out of the immediate family members of any deceased Life Member shall be entitled for Life Membership on application and on payment of the prevailing Membership fees. The term "Immediate Family Members" means the spouse,</p>

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	<p>son, daughter, grandson, granddaughter of the deceased Life Member. The Life Member has to nominate one of his immediate family members in writing for this category during his lifetime and submit the nomination to the Association.</p> <p>If the Life Member has not nominated his nominee during his lifetime, then after his/her death any one of his 'immediate family members' with the written consent of remaining adult 'immediate family members' can apply for membership within one year from the date of death of the Life Member. No application in this category will be entertained after one year from the date of the death of the Life Member.</p> <p>If the person so nominated has not attained the minimum age of 25 years at the time of the death of the Life Member or within one year thereof, as the case may be, he/she shall be enrolled for life membership upon attaining 25 years of age.</p> <p>A Life Member after the age of 65 years can transfer his/her Life Membership of MPCA to any one of his immediate family members.</p>
11 (A)	<p>Eligibility for admission under clause 7 (b) (i) and 7 (b) (ii) :</p> <p>A person :</p> <p>(a) Should be a citizen of India,</p> <p>(b) Should not have been declared to be of unsound mind,</p> <p>(c) Should not have been declared to be insolvent,</p> <p>(d) Should not have been convicted by a court of law for an offence involving moral turpitude.</p> <p>Any person who is a Life Member and has subsequently relinquished Indian Citizenship or has become of unsound mind or insolvent or convicted in any offence which come under (d) above shall be automatically disqualified from membership.</p> <p>(e) Against whom disciplinary action has been taken by the Committee, Association, Divisional Association or Board shall be debarred from applying for membership till such disability continues.</p>
12	<p>Procedure of applying for Membership : An individual person or an institution desiring to be a Member of the Association, shall apply in a prescribed form to the Hon. Secretary of the Association.</p> <p>(a) In case of individual persons, the prescribed form duly filled should be submitted alongwith a verification by the applicant to the effect that he is not otherwise disqualified from becoming the Member under any of the provisions of this constitution. Two Members of the Association should also recommend in the prescribed form that the applicant is duly qualified to become the Member of the Association.</p>

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	<p>(b) The Hon. Secretary of the Association, after receiving the application, shall place it before the Scrutiny Committee once in a year before 31<sup>st</sup> August. The Scrutiny Committee, after scrutinizing the application, shall place it before the Committee with its recommendation. The Committee may either admit the said applicant to the membership or reject the application or keep the application in abeyance for one subsequent year. The Committee shall not be bound to give reasons for rejecting or keeping in abeyance the application. The Hon. Secretary shall communicate the decision of the Committee to the applicant as soon as practicable.</p> <p>(c) An Institution or the Association of newly formed Division shall apply for the membership of the association in writing to the Hon. Secretary of the Association. The Hon. Secretary of the Association, after receiving the application, shall place the same before the Scrutiny Committee who in turn after scrutinising the same will place it before the Committee for appropriate action.</p> <p>(d) International Player shall have to submit his / her application informing Hon. Secretary that he/she has retired from the game prior to the date of submission of application, alongwith a proof, and his/her name shall be added as a Life Member of the Association after completion of all formalities of membership.</p>
13	<p>Privileges of a Member : The Members, except the Honorary Life Members, shall have the right given under this Constitution and in particular they shall have the right to be present at the meetings of the Association, the right to vote, the right to seek election, and the right to express opinion on all matters in accordance with the rules and regulation, provided that no Life Member shall have any such right unless he/she was a Life Member for a continuous period of six months immediately preceding the meeting of the general body / special general body / extra ordinary general body as the case may be.</p> <p>The clubs and institutions shall exercise the privileges of membership through the representative "duly named on their behalf".</p>
13 (A)	<p>Loss of Membership :</p> <p>The membership will be lost in the following cases:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(a) Death of the Member;</li> <li>(b) Insanity;</li> <li>(c) Default in payment of subscription for a period of two years;</li> <li>(d) Resignation;</li> <li>(e) Expulsion;</li> <li>(f) Conviction by a criminal court for offence involving moral turpitude;</li> <li>(g) Continuous non participation in any tournament recognised by the association or division by</li> </ul>

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		a Club/Institution for two years. (this is applicable only to Clubs and Institutions).
		It is clarified that if any retired first class / International cricketer, who has been admitted as a Life Member under such category, subsequently withdraws his / her retirement and resumes playing first class / international cricket then the Life Membership of the Association of such cricketer shall stand suspended up to the time he/she continues to play first class / International cricket.
14		Annual General Body Meeting of the Association : The Annual Meeting of the General Body of the Association shall be convened once in a year, preferably before the end of August. A notice of clear 21 days (from the date of despatch) of such meeting shall be given in writing to all eligible members through speed post, and through e-mail wherever practicable. The quorum for such meeting shall not be less than one third of the total membership. In the absence of the requisite quorum at the scheduled time, the meeting shall be adjourned for 15 minutes. The adjourned meeting shall be reconvened on the same day at the same venue. No quorum will be necessary for such adjourned meeting.
15		Business at the Annual Meeting : The Annual General Meeting shall transact the following business :
15 (a.a)		Confirmation of the minutes of the previous Annual General Meeting;
15 (a)		Adoption of annual report;
15(b)		Consideration and approval of audited statements of accounts and the audit report;
15(c)		Sanctioning of the annual budget;
15 (d)		Election of Office-bearers, Members of the Committee, <b>and the 'Cricket Committee'</b> in the year of election.
15(e)		Appointment of Auditors;
15(e.a)		Appointment of Ombudsmen cum Ethics Officer.
15(f)		<b>Consideration of any motion, notice whereof is given by a Member to the Secretary twenty-one days before the meeting. (Such a motion shall be circulated in advance to all members).</b>
15 (g)		Any other matter brought before it with the prior permission of the Chair.
16		Special General Body Meeting : A Special General Body Meeting shall be convened by the Hon. Secretary for the transaction of a specific business on - a. a directive by the President; or b. a resolution of the Committee; or

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		<p>c. a requisition signed by not less than twenty five percent Members of the Association.</p> <p>The agenda shall also include confirmation of the minutes of the previous Special General Body Meeting.</p> <p>No business other than for which the Special General Body Meeting is convened will be transacted at such Meeting.</p> <p>Ten days notice will be necessary for a Special General Body Meeting and the quorum shall be the same as in the case of Annual General Body Meeting.</p> <p><b>In the event of the Hon. Secretary failing to convene a Special General Meeting within thirty days of the receipt of a requisition, the requisitionists may themselves convene a Meeting for the purpose specified in the requisition at such place and time as may be decided by the requisitionists.</b></p>
17		<p>Extra ordinary General Body Meeting :</p> <p>The Hon. secretary shall convene an Extra Ordinary General Body Meeting to consider any amendment to the constitution either on directive of the president or if one fourth of the Members request the President in writing. Twenty one days notice shall be necessary for such meeting. An amendment to the constitution will be deemed to have been passed only if two-third of the Members present vote for it. <b>Any such amendment will not be given effect to without the leave of the Hon'ble Supreme Court.</b> The agenda shall also include confirmation of the minutes of the previous Extra Ordinary General Body Meeting.</p>
17(A)		<p>If any of the clauses of the Constitution are not clear or are not in accordance with the MP Societies Registration Act, the Registrar shall have power to amend the Constitution. On such a direction being received the Constitution shall stand amended, <b>subject to the leave of the Hon'ble Supreme Court being obtained.</b></p>
18		<p>Office-bearers :-</p> <p>(1) The following shall be the Office-bearers :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(a) President</li> <li>(b) Vice President</li> <li>(c) Hon. Secretary</li> <li>(d) Hon. Treasurer</li> <li>(e) Hon. Joint Secretary</li> </ul>

During the cooling off period, such an Office-bearer or an elected Member of the Committee / Apex Council of Board shall not be a Member of the Governing Council or of any committee whatsoever of the Board or of a State Association.</p> <p><b>The expressions 'Office bearer' and/or 'Member of the Committee / Apex Council of Board' should not be permitted to be circumvented by being a</b></p>

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

During the cooling off period, such an Office-bearer or an elected Member of the Committee / Apex Council of Board shall not be a Member of the Governing Council or of any committee whatsoever of the Board or of a State Association.</p> <p><b>The expressions 'Office bearer' and/or 'Member of the Committee / Apex Council of Board' should not be permitted to be circumvented by being a member of any other committee or of the Governing Council in Board or any State Association, as the case may be.</b></p>
19		<p>(5) The Committee may form any sub-committee which in its opinion is essential for better functioning of the Association. The scope of work and powers of any sub-committee shall</p>

  
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	be decided by the Committee.
19	(6) <b>No individual shall be a member of the Committee for more than 9 years. In the event of a member of the Committee completing 9 years before the expiry of his term, he shall cease to hold office on completion of 9 years.</b>
19	(7) <b>No nominated member of the Committee shall have more than one term of 3 years. It is clarified that the nominated member of the Committee referred here is the member as under provision 19 (1) (i) and 19 (1) (j)</b>
19	(8) <b>No member of the Committee, once elected, shall hold any office in a Divisional Association. The Divisional Association shall take steps to fill up the vacancy so created immediately.</b>
20	<p>Tenure and eligibility of the Office-bearer, Members of the Committee and sub-committee :</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The term for all post of office-bearer and the Committee, sub-committee shall be 3 years. All Office-bearers and elected Members of the Committee shall hold office for 3 years and may be eligible for re-election for another term immediately after the first term, but shall not be eligible to hold any such post for the third consecutive term. Any Office-bearers or elected Members of the Committee shall not be eligible to be Office-bearer or elected Members of the Committee for more than two terms consecutively. Such Office-bearer or the Member of the Committee will have to undergo a cooling off period of 3 years before being eligible for another term of 3 years.</li> <li>2. Deleted</li> <li>3. Ordinarily the term shall be from 1<sup>st</sup> September of a particular year and continue for 3 years till 31<sup>st</sup> August of that particular third year. In case the new Office-bearers, the Committee, and sub-committee is not constituted before 1<sup>st</sup> September then the Office-bearers, the Committee, and all sub-committees shall continue to hold office till such time as the new Committee is constituted.</li> <li>4. Election of the Offices Bearers and Members of the Committee : <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(a) All the Office-bearers and Members of the Committee shall be elected by the General Body in its annual meeting after every 3 years.</li> <li>(b) Election shall be held as prescribed in 21(2) below.</li> <li>(c) The Committee shall appoint an electoral officer who shall be a <b>former member of the Election Commission of India, or a former State Election Commissioner, or a</b></li> </ol> </li> </ol>

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**former Chief Electoral officer.** Such appointment shall be done at least one month prior to the elections.

- (d) The electoral officer shall oversee and supervise the entire election process for Office-bearer & Members of the Committee **including scrutiny of the electoral rolls**, which shall include all nominations and candidature being subject to his scrutiny in accordance with the provisions of this Constitution.
- (e) In case of any dispute or objection as to candidate's disqualification, eligibility to vote, or the admission or rejection of a vote in these elections, the electoral officer shall decide the same and such decision shall be final and conclusive.
- (f) **The electoral officer shall have powers to issue 'practice directions' to facilitate smooth functioning of his office in handling the matters before him.**

## **2. Procedure for Election :-**

The following shall be the procedure for election :

- (i) The election schedule shall be appended to the Notice for Annual General Body Meeting in which elections are to be held.
- (ii) The Hon. Secretary shall display a list of eligible Members who can participate in the election (i.e. list of eligible voters) on the date of issue of election schedule on the notice board of the Associations' office.

(2) Conflict of interest :

**A. The provisions relating to conflict of interest in Rule 38(1) of the BCCI Constitution shall mutatis mutandis be applicable to the Association.**


B. Within a period of 15 days of taking any office under the Association, every individual shall disclose in writing to the Committee any existing or potential event that may be deemed to cause a conflict of interest, and the same shall be uploaded on the website of the Association. The failure to issue such a complete disclosure or any partial or total suppression thereof would render the individual open to disciplinary action which may include termination and removal from such office / post / role without benefits. It is clarified that a declaration does not lead to a presumption that in fact a questionable situation exists, but is merely for information and transparency.

C. A conflict of interest may be either tractable or intractable :

- (i) Tractable conflicts are those that are resolvable or permissible or excusable through refusal of the individual concerned and/or with full disclosure of the interest involved.
- (ii) Intractable conflicts are those that cannot be resolved through disclosure and refusal, and would necessitate the removal of the individual from a post or position occupied so that the conflict can cease to exist.

D. It is clarified that no individual may occupy more than one of the following posts at a single point of time except where prescribed under this Constitution:

- (i) Player (current)
- (ii) Selector/Member of cricket committee/sub-committee
- (iii) Team official
- (iv) Commentator
- (v) Match official
- (vi) Administrator/Office-bearer

  
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- (vii) Electoral officer
- (viii) Ombudsman and ethics officer
- (ix) Auditor
- (x) Any person who is in governance, management or employment of a franchisee.
- (xi) Member of a standing committee
- (xii) CEO and managers
- (xiii) Office-bearer of an Institutional Member
- (xiv) Service provider (legal, finance, etc.)
- (xv) Contractual entity (broadcast, security, contactor, etc.)
- (xvi) Owner of a cricket academy

As far as incumbents are concerned every disclosure mandated above may be made within 90 days of the effective date.

3. The ombudsman cum ethics officer

- (i) The Association shall appoint an independent ombudsman cum ethics officer at the annual general body meeting.
- (ii) The terms of reference for the ombudsman cum ethics officer shall be framed by the Committee and include regulations regarding the discipline and conduct of the players, match officials, team officials, administrators, members, and other associated with the Association.

**The ombudsman cum ethics officer shall have powers to issue 'practice directions' to facilitate smooth functioning of his office in handling the matters before him.**

- (iii) Ombudsman cum ethics officer shall be a retired Judge of High Court so appointed by the Association after obtaining his/her consent and on terms as determined by the Association in keeping with the dignity and stature of the office.
- (iv) The term of an ombudsman cum ethics officer shall be one year subject to a maximum of three terms in office.
- (v) Any instance of conflict of interest may be taken cognizance by the said officer :
  - (a) Suo Motu;
  - (b) By way of a complaint in writing to the official postal or email address of the Association **supported by an Affidavit, duly attested/notarized by Oath Commissioner/Notary Public; Or**
  - (c) On a reference by the Committee;
- (vi) After considering the relevant factors and following the principles of natural justice, the

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

55	Settlement of Disputes : The Registrar or any other Officer authorised by him shall investigate the affairs of the Association in case of any dispute and shall have full powers to settle disputes or give decision which will be binding on all parties for compliance. It shall be the duty of all the office-bearers and officers of the Association to produce all books and papers relating to the Association.
56	Power of Registrar to call meeting : If default is made in holding meetings of General body or Committee in accordance with the registered constitution of the Association or when it becomes otherwise necessary in the opinion of the Registrar, the Registrar shall have power to call or direct the calling of General Meeting or Committee meeting of the Association and give ancillary or consequential directions as he may consider necessary for conducting meeting.
56 A	Indemnity – Every Member of the Association, every Office-bearer / other official or staff, or a Member of a Committee or Sub-committee for the time being of the Association and every Trustee thereof shall be indemnified out of the Association's fund against all losses and expenses incurred in the discharge of his /her duties, except those which have occurred through his / her own wilful act or chargeable only for so much moneys or properties as he / she shall himself / herself actually receive for or in the discharge of the business of the Association and each one shall be answerable only for his / her own act, neglects or default and not for those of any other person.
56 B	Suit by or against the Association : The Association shall sue or be sued in the name of the Hon. Secretary
57	<p>Repeal and Savings : The Madhya Bharat Cricket Constitution as applied to Madhya Bharat as in force immediately before this Constitution comes into force and the rules made thereunder is hereby repealed.</p> <p>Provided that :</p> <p>(a) the persons admitted to the membership, clubs and institutions affiliated to the said Association, the office-bearers, the members, representative elected or nominated by or in the Committee or any sub-committee shall continue to hold the same post or status until superseded, elected, nominated under this Constitution;</p> <p>(b) any property or right acquired, any privilege accrued or any liability or obligation incurred, shall not be affected;</p> <p>(c) any agreement or appointment made, any action or decision taken shall be deemed to have been taken under this Constitution.</p>
