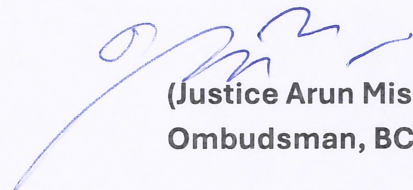
**OMBUDSMAN
THE BOARD OF CONTROL FOR CRICKET IN INDIA**

In Re: Complaint dated 28.04.2025 made by Mr. Agam Rao with regard to Hyderabad Cricket Association (HCA), sent to the Ombudsman, Board of Control for Cricket in India

ORDER

1. This complaint has been filed under Rule 41 of the Rules and Regulations of the Board of Control for Cricket in India, alleging inaction by the BCCI in respect of HCA's failure to comply with the directions, orders and recommendations of the BCCI.
2. Prayer has been made that the Ombudsman conducts an Inquiry to ensure compliance and implementation of BCCI orders by the HCA and to ensure that funds provided to HCA by the BCCI are spent for District Level Coaching Tournaments and infrastructure development on a priority and continuous basis.
3. It is for the concerned authorities of the BCCI to see compliance with BCCI directions in respect of coaching, tournaments, infrastructure development etc. Without commenting on the merits of the complaint. The complainant is so advised may approach concerned authorities of BCCI. With the aforesaid liberty, the complaint is disposed of.
