OMBUDSMAN THE BOARD OF CONTROL FOR CRICKET IN INDIA

In Re: Complaint dated 27.09.2025 made by Mr. Allipuram Venkateswar Reddy, in relation to Hyderabad Cricket Association, sent to the Ombudsman, Board of Control for Cricket in India.

ORDER

- 1. Complaint dated 27.09.2025 is received by Ombudsman, filed by Mr. Allipuram Venkateswar Reddy, who claims to be Ex. Chairman, Telangana Sports Authority & President, Telangana Districts Cricket Association. Prayer has been made for formation of a separate Cricket Association i.e. "Telangana Districts Cricket Association".
- 2. Complainant alleges that discrimination is taking place with respect to cricket players from rural Telangana. Grievance in this regard is against the "Hyderabad Cricket Association". It is inter alia alleged that even though 11 years have passed since formation of the State of Telangana, 32 Districts are still not taken into consideration by the Hyderabad Cricket Association.
- 3. The issues raised in the complaint are basically policy issues, do not fall within the jurisdiction of Ombudsman. As such, complaint is not maintainable. Complainant is at liberty to approach appropriate concerned authorities for redressal of the various issues raised.
- 4. Complaint is disposed of with aforesaid liberty.
