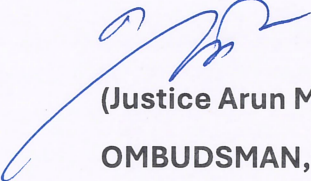

THE BOARD OF CONTROL FOR CRICKET IN INDIA**

**In Re: Complaint dated 09.08.2025 made by Mr. M. Natesh, sent to the
Ombudsman, Board of Control for Cricket in India**

ORDER:

1. The complainant has alleged that the election to the State Managing Committee of the Karnataka State Cricket Association (KSCA) is around the corner and the complainant is receiving communication via e-mail that several members who have completed 9-year terms have announced/are contemplating their candidature. If they are not prevented, the action would violate decision of the Apex Court in State of Bihar Vs. BCCI.
2. Prayer has been made to issue direction to the KSCA, through its Managing Committee/Electoral Officer, to adhere to the decision/direction of the Apex Court. Further prayer made is that proxy to the General Body for voting in election should be stopped.
3. The complaint is premature and same is not maintainable. The complainant has the remedy before the committee or Electoral Officer to raise the objection. No such direction as prayed for can be issued. The process of election has not yet started. Complaint is vague and based on surmises and conjectural reasonings. Hence same is dismissed.
